Dear Resident:

You have expressed an interest in having a tree planted by the City in the right-of-way (area between curb and sidewalk) at your residence. The Department of Public Services will again be planting street trees this fall. If you are NOT interested, please disregard this letter – no reply is necessary.

The newly planted tree will be 8 to 10 feet tall and have an approximate 2 -2½ inch trunk. Enclosed is a list of trees to choose from with the description of their characteristics and cost.

Residents are also welcome to purchase trees for planting on their private property. The City will **not** plant trees on private property but will deliver the trees to the property and place the trees on the right-of-way.

Trees are purchased at wholesale pricing and do not come with any type of warranty. Please complete the attached Request / Receipt Form, detach and return by September 2, 2016 with payment to:

TREE DESCRIPTIONS – Fall 2016

- NOTE:** Small Trees - Limited growing area and good for under utility wires. Right-of-way space of less than 5 feet.
Medium Trees - Right-of-way space of at least 6 feet (from curb to sidewalk). No overhead wires.
Large Trees - Right-of-way space of at least 8 feet. No overhead wires.

SMALL

CLEVELAND PEAR (aka Chanticleer) \$175 **OFFICIAL TREE OF THE CITY OF ROSEVILLE

Height 37' and Width 15' (at age 30)

Leaves: Glossy green turning brilliant gold-red to plum in the fall

Characteristics: Its conical form, maintained through maturity, has a tailored appearance. Especially suitable where space to spread is limited. It is resistant to fire blight, thornless, and much less susceptible to wind breakage

SERVICE BERRY AUTUMN BRILLIANCE \$195

Height 20' and Width to 15' (at age 30)

Leaves: Petite blue-green, turns brilliant reddish-orange in the fall.

Characteristics: Upright growth with flowers in spring, starting out pale pink and changing to white. Purplish-black fruit in the fall.

MEDIUM

CRIMSON KING NORWAY MAPLE \$175

Height 40' and Width 25' (at age 30)

Leaves: Purplish red color retained from Spring to Fall, then turn to brown.

Characteristics: Oval shape, rounded at maturity, popular for its color. Slow to moderate grower that is nearly seedless.

REGAL PETTICOAT SYCAMORE MAPLE \$180

(This tree will be approximately 1¾" in diameter and 8' tall when planted)

Height 40' and Width 30' (at age 30)

Leaves: Mature leaves are dark glossy green with velvety burgundy-purple undersides; fall leaves are yellow with pink-salmon undersides.

Characteristics: Beautiful street tree with a vase-shaped form. This tree grows at a medium rate, it has no negative characteristics and is apparently seedless.

HEARTY HYBRID ELM: \$165

Height 50' and Width 25' (at age 30)

Leaves: Large, green, serrated; turning yellow in autumn

Characteristics: Hybrid Elm with a moderately vase shaped crown. Inconspicuous flowers. Bark is ash-gray. Highly tolerant to Dutch Elm disease and Elm leaf beetle. This tree is very adaptable and makes a great street tree.

LARGE

GREENSPIRE LITTLELEAF LINDEN \$160

Height 45' and Width 30' (at age 30)

Leaves: Leathery, small, dark green leaves.

Characteristics: Dense, upright growth habit, and a strong central leader; growth is more rapid than the species. Flowers are yellowish, pendulous clusters, very fragrant and attractive to bees

ARMSTRONG RED MAPLE: \$170

Height 50'-60' and Width 12'-18' (at age 30)

Leaves: New foliage emerges red, turning green for the summer. Nice red, orange, or yellow fall color.

Characteristics: Attractive silver-gray bark. Fast growing, upright growth pattern makes a great street tree that tolerates heat and drought. Red flowers bloom in the spring. Typical double winged samara as with other Maples. The seeds are quite popular with squirrels and birds.

GREEN MT. SUGAR MAPLE: \$170

Height 40'-60' and Width 35' (at age 30)

Leaves: Dark green in summer, somewhat leathery. Turn brilliant shades of burnt orange and red in fall.

Characteristics: Features a symmetrical canopy with a smooth outline: Yellow spring flowers. Typical double winged samara as with other Maples. This species will tolerate a wide variety of soil types.
