

The Department of Public Works has no objection to this request with the following stipulations:

- 1) Lighted Barricades (2- per side, total of 4) must be put up at both ends of the street closing. The barricades must be picked up at the DPW yard on Friday 6/7/13 by 2:30pm. A \$35.00 per barricade deposit is required (\$140.00 due at time of pickup). Barricades must be returned by 2:30pm Monday 6/10/13.
- 2) All party set ups and debris must be picked up and removed from the city street, city property and right of ways by 11:00pm Sunday June 9, 2013.
