COMPOST COLLECTION INFORMATION

COMPOST COLLECTION - Leaves, grass clippings, yard and garden cuttings must be curbside by **7:00 a.m.** on your **regular** day of collection, from April through the first week of December (check the City calendar for exact dates each year). These materials are now "**BANNED**" from landfills. Therefore, all compost type material will be collected separately. These items will only be collected if placed out according to the following rules:

- **NO PLASTIC BAGS!** Clear, black, or colors are **NOT ACCEPTABLE. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- **30-35 GALLON CANS** with our COMPOST STICKER. These compost stickers are available FREE at City Hall, DPS, Parks and Recreation & Fire Dept. Cans cannot weigh more than 60 lbs.
- **30 GALLON BROWN KRAFT PAPER BAG.** This is the **ONLY** acceptable bag. Available at City of Roseville Treasurer and many local retailers.
- **BUNDLES FOR TREE TRIMMINGS / BRUSH / BRANCHES** (less than 2 inches in diameter). Each bundle can be up to 4 feet long and 18 inches in diameter. **NOT entire bushes.** No trunks or stumps. Please tie securely.
- **COMPOST** placed out *improperly* will **NOT** be picked up.
- **DO NOT BLOW OR RAKE GRASS OR LEAVES INTO THE STREET. GRASS AND LEAVES ARE TO BE PLACED IN COMPOST BAGS OR CANS ONLY.**

DPS CHIPPER SERVICE FOR UNBUNDLED BRUSH AND BRANCHES:

Unbundled Brush and Tree Branches (larger than 2 inches in diameter) will **NOT** be picked up with the CURBSIDE COLLECTION. The DPS Forestry Chipper Service is available for \$70.00 per hour, with a 1/2 hour (\$35.00) minimum charge. A simple contract must be signed before this work can be scheduled. Call the DPS (586-445-5470) for more information. In most cases, the charge for this service is the \$35.00 minimum charge.
