The Water Department wrote specifications for Road Materials for Year 2012. Invitations to bid were sent to five (5) companies with three (3) companies responding.

The low bid meeting specifications for Black Top/Winter Mix was from Barrett Paving Materials in the amount of \$93.50/ton. The low bid meeting specification for Cold Patch was also from Barrett Paving Materials in the amount of \$100.00/ton. The breakdown is as follows:

The Water Department has reviewed all bids and finds that the low bidder meets specifications. The City has successfully done business with Barrett Paving Materials for many years.

Therefore, it is recommended, based on estimated quantities the bid be awarded for Black Top/Winter Mix to **Barrett Paving Materials** in the amount of **\$93.50/ton**; Cold Patch also to be awarded to **Barrett Paving Materials** in the amount of **\$100.00/ton**.
