A second Public hearing will be held April 11th, 2017 before City of Roseville City Council in the City Council Chambers. The purpose of the CDBG Program is to undertake projects and activities which meet one of the three national objectives for the program, which seek to 1) benefit low and moderate-income persons, 2) aid in the prevention or elimination of slums and blight, or 3) meet other community development needs having particular urgency. Individuals are welcome to make comments on any aspect of the proposal or its programs. Assistance is available upon request to handicapped persons wishing to appear.
