This will continue the funding of financial aid and services for Macomb County veterans and support the administration of the Macomb County Department of Veterans' Affairs and Macomb County Veterans' Affairs Commission.

Miller	Shall the 0.04 mills, (4 cents per \$1,000 of taxable value), increase on the limitation on the amount of taxes imposed on taxable property in Macomb County which expires in 2018 be increased by 0.029 mills to a revised total of 0.069 mills for 2017 and 2018 and be renewed at 0.069 mills for four (4) years, 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022 to be levied by Macomb County on taxable real and personal property for the remaining two years of the current authorization, 2017 and 2018 and an additional four years, 2019 through 2022, inclusive, for the purpose of providing financial aid and services for Macomb County veterans and to support the administration of the Macomb County Department of Veterans' Affairs and Macomb County Veterans' Affairs Commission? It is estimated that a levy of 0.069 mills will raise approximately \$1,756,375 in the first calendar year of the levy. For example, on a property having a residential market value of \$100,000 (estimated taxable value of \$80,000), 0.069 mills would be \$3.45 of levied tax annually.

		MACOMB COUNTY ZOOLOGICAL AUTHORITY RENEWAL MILLAGE
		The Macomb County Zoological Authority was established pursuant to Public Act 48 of 2008 and formed to allow for continuing zoological services for the students, residents and visitors of Macomb County. The law allows the Authority to seek authorization from the electors to levy a tax on real and personal property to provide revenue to an accredited zoological institution for this purpose. Accordingly, as a renewal of the previously approved millage authorization which expires with the 2017 tax levy, to continue providing zoological services to benefit the residents of the County, shall the 0.1 mill (10 cents per \$1,000 of taxable value) on all of the taxable property located within the County continue to be imposed for a period of ten (10) years, being years 2018 through 2027? It is estimated that if approved and levied, this millage would generate approximately \$2,563,833 in 2018.

LIBRARY MILLAGE PROPOSAL

Shall the tax limitation imposed on all taxable real and tangible personal property within the City of Roseville, Macomb County, Michigan be increased for the City in an amount not to exceed 0.5 mill (\$.50 on each \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of ten (10) years, 2016 to 2025, inclusive, to provide funds for library operations, equipment, facilities and materials pursuant to Section 10 of 1877 P.A. 164 and for all other library purposes authorized by law, and shall the City levy such new additional millage for said purposes? The estimate of the revenue the City will collect if the millage is approved and levied in the 2016 calendar year is approximately \$424,895.00. The revenue from this millage will be dispersed into a library fund that is under the exclusive control of an independent public library board.
