RECREATION CENTER GYM RENTALS

Gymnasiums are available for rentals on a limited basis for your group or organization to plan a fun-filled day or evening of basketball or volleyball. The Recreation Authority has established a very user friendly inflatable and park entertainment policy.

We encourage our park rental groups to make the most of their party experience! Our department approved vendor list offers competitive pricing and a large variety of entertainment options. Additionally, each approved vendor is required to submit updated liability insurance annually to the Recreation Authority.

A vendor list is available at the Recreation Authority or on our website www.rare-mi.org. All inflatable and park entertainment **MUST** be an approved vendor from our list.

Rental groups who utilize one of our approved rental companies must fill out an additional park entertainment form and return it at least 10 business days before their reservation date.

Please Note: You must have a paid pavilion rental in order to schedule park entertainment.




