Re: Excess Workers Compensation Coverage Renewal

Submissions were made on the City's behalf for Excess Workers Compensation Coverage by Stephen Saph of Nickel & Saph, Inc. to two (2) Companies, Safety National Casualty and Midwest Employers Casualty Company. Safety National Casualty did not respond to the submission because of a non-competitive premium.

Midwest Employers Casualty Company quoted a total annual premium of \$46,427 with retention of \$500,000. This represents an increase of \$6,402 over last year's premium of \$40,025. This is due to the increase in the estimated payroll roll of \$1,080,750 for the next fiscal year.

This submission was evaluated by Stephen Saph, Nickel & Saph, Inc. and myself. Midwest Employers Casualty Company represents other municipalities and the City in a satisfactory manner. Therefore, it is recommended that the City award the Excess Workers Compensation Renewal to Midwest Employers Casualty Company in the amount of \$46,427. The proposal is available for your review.
