PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS

A fee of Thirty Five Dollars (\$35.00) will be required for each set of Specifications and will not be refunded. A mailing fee of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) to cover postage and handling will be charged to anyone wishing to receive the specifications via United Parcel Services.

BID SECURITY

A certified check, or the included Bid Bond, executed by the bidder and a surety company, payable to the City of Roseville, in an amount at least equal to five percent (5%) of the bid, shall be submitted with each bid.

WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS

No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) calendar days after the receipt of bids.

AWARD OF CONTRACT

The City of Roseville reserves the right to reject any or all bids and/or to waive any irregularities in bidding. The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory performance, payment, maintenance and guarantee bonds and insurance certificates.

STATE AND FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS

Attention is called to the fact that not less than the minimum salaries and wages set forth in the Contract Documents must be paid on this project. The Contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex or national origin, in accordance with Executive Order 11246 Equal Employment Opportunity and Notice of Requirement for Affirmative Action to Ensure Equal Employment Opportunity. The Contractor will comply with Section 3 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968, as amended. Contractors bidding on this project must follow, document, and maintain documentation of their Good Faith Efforts to ensure that Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBEs) have the opportunity to participate in the project by increasing DBE awareness of procurement efforts and outreach. Responsible Bidders which are Certified DBE or Section 3 Business Concerns may be given preference when evaluating bids.
