**WHEREAS,** The impact of mental and substance use disorders are apparent in every local community; and,

**WHEREAS,** An estimated 21.6 million people aged 12 or older in the United States needed treatment for an illicit drug or alcohol use problem in 2011, with only approximately 2.3 million receiving treatment for alcohol or illicit drug problems; and,

**WHEREAS,** stigma and discrimination present obstacles and can be a mark of disgrace to those with substance use disorders who need access to treatment facilities, and for those who want to re-establish their place in the community by entering the workforce; and,


**WHEREAS,** educating our community about substance use disorders is essential to combat the misconceptions associated with addiction; substance use disorders affect all people of every age, race, gender, ethnicity, community, and socio-economic status; and

**WHEREAS,** we must recognize the achievement of those who seek out treatment services and ensure that such services are readily available to those who need assistance; and,







U.S. Constitution Week**




**WHEREAS**, Public Law 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America designating Constitution Week; and,






