**DIAPER NEED AWARENESS WEEK  
SEPTEMBER 28 – OCTOBER 4, 2015**

**Whereas**, Diaper Need, the condition of not having a sufficient supply of clean diapers to ensure that infants and toddlers are clean, healthy and dry, can adversely affect the health and welfare of infants, toddlers and their families; and

**Whereas**, national surveys report that one in three mothers experiencing diaper need at some time while their children are less than three years of age and forty-eight percent of families delay changing a diaper to extend their supply; and

**Whereas**, the average infant or toddler requires an average of 50 diapers changes per week over three years; and

**Whereas**, obtaining a sufficient supply of diapers can cause economic hardship to families; and

**Whereas**, a supply of diapers is generally an eligibility requirement for infant and toddlers to participate in childcare programs and quality early education programs; and

**Whereas**, the people of Roseville recognize that addressing Diaper Need can lead to economic opportunity for families in need and can lead to improved health for families and their community; and

**Whereas**, Roseville is proud to be home to various community organizations such as Macomb Feeding the Need that recognize the importance of diapers in helping provide economic stability for families and distribute diapers to families in need through various channels.

**Now, Therefore**, the Mayor and Council of the City of Roseville do hereby proclaim the week of September 28 – October 4, 2015 as Diaper Need Awareness Week and encourage the citizens of Roseville to donate generously to Macomb Feeding the Need so it may distribute diapers to families in need to help alleviate diaper need in our community.
