Honorable Mayor and Council of the City of Roseville, with your concurrence, the Roseville Police Department intends to apply for the 2016 Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant sponsored by the United States Department of Justice. The grant, which requires no matching funds from the city, is set at \$17,500.00. The police department intends to use the funds, once allocated to purchase a Bosch Crash Data Retrieval System. This device allows for the retrieval of crash data from a motor vehicles on-board computer systems. This data assists the investigator in determining causation of a crash and helping to determine what if any charges should be sought.

Academy Street: Limited to one way traffic only from 11 Mile Road to Chestnut Street

Academy Street: No parking on west side of Academy Street from 11 Mile Road to Chestnut Street

Woodland Street: Limited to one way traffic only from Chestnut Street to 11 Mile Road

Woodland Street: No Parking on the east side of Woodland Street from Chestnut Street to 11 Mile Road

**AMENDED RESOLUTION CREATING EDISON DRIVE
SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICT
NO. 2016-01**

At a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Roseville, held in the Council Chambers, Roseville Municipal Complex, 29777 Gratiot Avenue, Roseville, Michigan, 48066 on May 24, 2016 at 7:00p.m.

WHEREAS, the City of Roseville has conducted several public meetings regarding the condition of Edison Drive within the City of Roseville and has determined that substantial repairs are necessary for the purposes of health, safety and welfare as well as continued economic development and job retention;

WHEREAS, The City Manager in accordance with provisions of the City of Roseville Code of Ordinances, Chapter 5: Assessments, Special, Section 5-4, has received from the City Engineer a survey and condition report of the proposed Drive improvement area and conducted a review into the need to proceed with improvements and a proposed Special Assessment District for the purposes of funding such improvements;

WHEREAS, Community meetings have been held with property owners within the proposed special assessment district and project estimates prepared in the amount of \$807,512.14;

WHEREAS, The City of Roseville has received a Transportation Economic Development Fund Grant from the State of Michigan in an amount not to exceed 79% of the total cost to defer the cost of the project;

WHEREAS, the City of Roseville has budgeted to contribute \$100,000.00 of the remaining estimated balance of the project from its Local Drive Fund (Fund #203) and proposes to spread the final estimated costs of \$69,577.55 plus interest across the properties within the proposed special assessment on an equal per front foot formula of which a detailed special assessment roll shall be prepared for the purpose of defraying the remaining cost of the proposed improvements;

WHEREAS, the proposed special assessment district and proposed assessment roll shall be subject to a public meeting for the purpose of hearing any objection to either the proposed district or assessment roll. Said meeting shall be held on Tuesday June 28, 2016 at 7:00p.m. Such notice shall be mailed to all proposed properties within the district as well as published in a newspaper of general circulation. The proposed special assessment roll shall also be available for public inspection during normal office hours at the Roseville City Hall prior to the scheduled public meeting;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Roseville, Macomb County, Michigan, resolves as follows:

Pursuant to Section 5-4 and 5-5 of Chapter 5 of the City Code of Ordinances, the City Council hereby determines to proceed with the improvements to Edison Drive and hereby establishes The Edison Drive Special Assessment District, Number 2016-01 to defray the cost of proposed Drive improvements by special assessment upon the properties specially benefited in proportion to the benefits to be derived.
